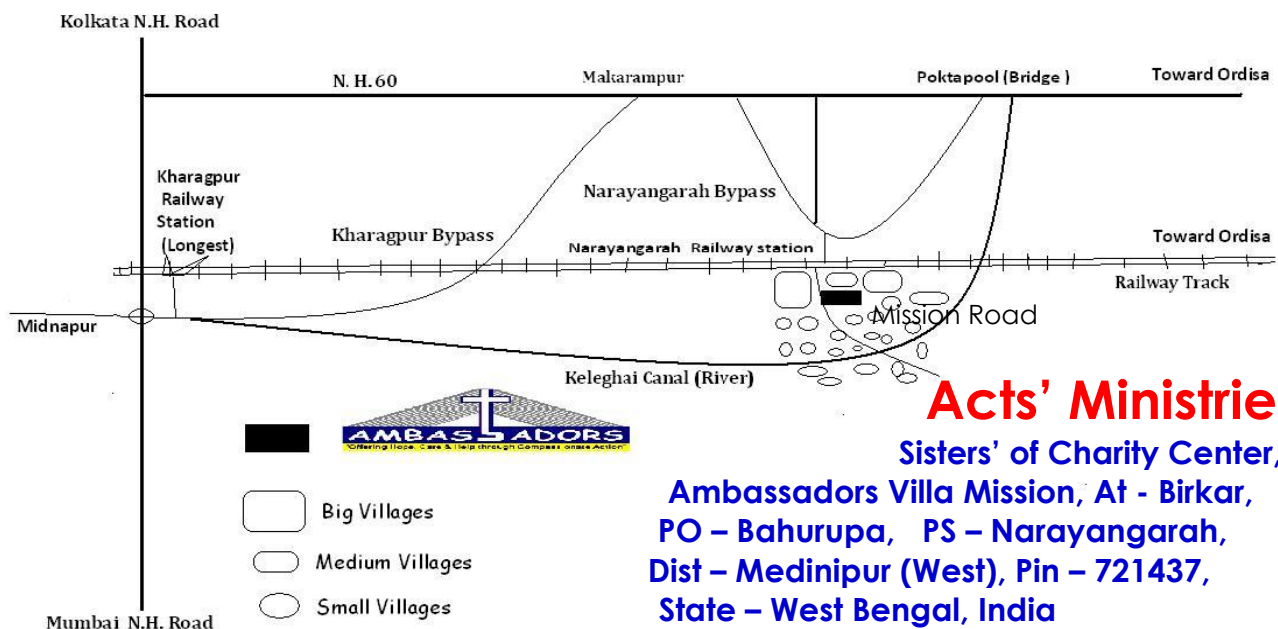

Home Authority was helpless and took help of Culcutta High Court through Public Litigation No. W.P.1344 of 2011 before Chief Justice J. N. Patel and Justice A. K. Roy bench. But school Authority & their team use all power so that I & other four friends may not able to continue in study because we do not have parents. In this crucial situation I had been grownup and thankful to God for all His grace and also those who helped.*

*In the life, Battle never end but where is pain there is gain of Maturity & Success. Therefore We are in the battle and our team is very small and weak in many areas but trying our best to be good servent hearted.*

**A lot of frozen problems have designed a rainbow colored cobweb in the reference area from the very beginning.**

- † **Alarming menace of damaging crops productivity each year for dry baron agricultural field, imbalance rainfall, scarcity of irrigation and very poor soil fertility. Soil: Lateritic & Alluvial (Poor red and rocky soil depth) and Drought Prone area**
- † **High population growth rate and low literacy rates especially in Lodha and other tribal areas**
- † **Very poorly developed infrastructure in the area**
- † **Widespread poverty, with high concentration of Tribal, Scheduled Caste and Other Backward Castes**
- † **Rigid Caste structure**
- † **Exploitative practices including money – lending**
- † **Extremely limited role of women in community activities but in tribal area they have to earn to survive the family**
- † **Agriculture the primary livelihood source, less than 15% of the cultivable land where two times cultivation taken place in year**
- † **Unbearable burden of indebtedness by the maximum below poverty line villagers, marginal farmers, landless daily wage earners and minorities.**
- † **For daily needs maximum people are depends on forest**
- † **Child been taking care by other child**

## Crucial Days

- Acts Public School in month of Dec 2015 Mrs.Tikilota Dolai suddenly left who was all in all in that said school at that time we don't have own building it was running Ambassadors Tower. School was without class in 4month after her left at that time only 4girls child.
- In 2016 in Acts Academy (Bengali Junier High School) at saldanga Mr.



Uttam Pradhan who was school in charged but we could found that he completely involved in non educational work during school hrs. Ms Barnali Das was strongly acused not to admit any child in this school from Gilgal Children Home & other area who was temporary superaintendent of the home in those days. She took full help of Mr. Uttam and both marched and tried to stop

at that time we brought Mr. Rolinson Hansda but after 3 month he could not able to do continue. In this very bed situation we had made dicision to stop the the school in the middle of year in month of May 2016 and it was closed down permanently.

- In 2018 in month of Feb in Acts Public School sudden left the school in charged Mr. Kalicharn Murmu and his wife Rupali at night by stolen morethan Rs. 17,000/-. He was taking all answer papers of the students & left except last exam papers, it was final exam time.



- From March in 2019, Bappa & Sulochona Kotal gave hard time to stop the Villa Mission. Sulochona was in-charge soon after they leaved, they have started own their hostel by taking our two children and trying to stop the Mission by giving pressures to local staffs and beneficiaries.



- Bro Hopna took all risk become in-charge who was very much weak in mind & health in that time. Bro Hopna was not counted by many wise & educated because of his much obedient to the task.

- Gita Hembram in middle of the year suddenly gave harassed with her selfish motive after taking all the supports of her B Tech studies. She had promised to serve the needy & she was signatory of Banks but her high ambition of status made even shameful for her Santali tribe. In this very crucial and lacking situations Bro Bimal become more active to face these such challenges, even Gita had been not doing in action just she used to do signing only & she also used to makes other discouraged to serving the poor. Her contrary decision to promise given by her brought more than enough discouraged but this can be experienced of Charity.



## : Activities for the year of 2022-2023:

### Children HOME /Orphange

#### Origin:

Dr. Dutta once got chance to visit the Lodha (tribal) village at Narayangarah in the year of 2005 with well-wisher **Mr. Anup Midya**, what he had seen the affliction, distress; pain & suffering of lodha children that upset his heart & that harrowing experience give a Fillip to the idea of giving birth to this Villa Mission. In that, so cold time children do not had little cloth in their body and many usband left their wife so children are in suffering, this 90% people are landless, and under local



liquor, who do not care own their children. Rev. Dr. Dutta immediate step took by purchasing a piece of land by owns his money in month of December 2006 in the name of Institution at Bahurupa (Birkar) village. But in that time we could not able to start any development/ building on that land because of lack of fund and in those days in this mission field anti social person work strongly to stop the development (Bikas Maity). It was a time of God's blessing that Dr. L. N. Jana a principal of Patharhuri Mission School provided

about 80,000/- rupees from school fund to start the building work through that amount temporary building was constructed. In 29<sup>th</sup> Dec, 2009 by faith footsteps has taken and admitted 10 children inaugurated the home at that time daily maintenances fund has been provided by Dr. Dutta up to April 2010. In addition, **Sr. Rita Rana** took big challenge, she dedicated herself and stayed with the children of this Lodha village, and it was strong decision for this young Lady. No water facilities, No proper sanitation system, and no relative close by but trusting the Lord, and she stayed and work for the needy children about 2years.

Two Young people (Maloti Hansda & Mr. Bibek Mahato) who dedicated for the service who are giving cares to our loving home children, All the home children admitted in baturupa, primary schools. The local people are so cooperatives to such healthy activities. Therefore, Acts family is so thankful for their care and acceptance.



The home took all responsibilities if child once got admission in this orphanage. Children knew that this is their own home, Home providing daily needs as cloths, hygiene, and entertainment items, and other hobbies items. In yearly having, sports, tour, picnic, cultural program and observe memorial days. Few Children do gardening own their interest. Children learn dances, songs and they followed the holistic scheduled. Last financial year 18 children residing but still unable to find donors because of these we are in pain for daily meeting the needs.

On 7<sup>th</sup> January 2016 dated '**ACTS' PUBLIC SCHOOL'** foundation stone was laid at **Narayangarah** Development block at Bahurupa By Rev. Nikhiles & Sunita Bhunia - Founder of AWS, and Dr Dutt - Founder President of Acts.

## Hostel: -

The poverty remains the most serious problems that our area faces. India still has the World's largest number of poor people dwelling on its land. Of the population of more than 1.2 Billion, an estimated 444 million are below poverty line, out of which 61 percent dwell in rural areas of the country. Most of them are daily wage earners, landless laborers and selfemployed ouseholders. The children of such evil, cursed families are forced to take up jobs at a tender age.

They are not only derived from the golden dream of childhood but education too adding to the illiterate bulk of the country. Being gradually the merciless victims of child abuse they turned into child labour, which is the most valuable waste of human resources. They are doomed to remain poor for the rest of their live and thus the mortality rate is high among them.

To protect innocent promising childhood ACTS' MINISTRIES has set up one Hostel for destitute, in Acts' Mission Center at Saldanga where 60 learners are residing now blissfully.



## Women Empowerment: -

*"She means the World"- promoting empowerment of women may be just one of the 8th millennium development goals, but this aspect is crucial to success in all of the seven others. That's why it was said by Pandit Jawharlal Nehru, "You can tell the condition of a nation by looking at the status of its women". The Constitution of India enjoins upon every citizen of India the duty. "To promote the common brotherhood of all the people of India and renounces any practice derogatory of the dignity of women." At all the stages of life, right from the childhood to the old age, she has been a subordinate position to man. The average woman has always led a life not better than that of a slave. They have been, since ages, time, place and society victims of humiliation, torture, exploitation and violence. Violence against women can be categorized under three boards – (i) Criminal Violence as rape, abduction or murder. (ii)-Domestic Violence- which includes dowry-deaths, wife battering, sexual abuse, maltreatment of widows or elderly women and lastly (iii) Social Violence which includes forcing a wife or daughter in law to go to female foeticide, eve-teasing, molestation, mental torture, refusing to give a share in property, to commit suicide or forcing to use in business interest by which they get respite from such rampant disregardation.*

The women members are utilizing this assisted money in different producing work fields like Baro Cultivation, Pig Farming, Goat Farming, Cow farming for milk, Poultry farming, Leaf-dish Making, purchasing Toto, Tailoring & Garment making and many such other rural industry. Thus they are gradually increasing per capita income day by day as an extra for their under privileged family too. Still Loan provided Rs. 118,800/- Near future it will be a triumph of value detected honor of womanhood. In the society's eye it would be true-
